

FACT SHEET

The Sacramento State Construction Management Program creates an entrepreneurial pathway for students by partnering with industry professionals who create strong correlations between education and application.

Each year, Construction Management Students at Sacramento State are given an unprecedented opportunity to participate in the ASC Student Competition in Reno. Students must complete an application and those selected compete on one of 7 teams:

- Heavy Civil Division
- Design-Build Division
- Commercial Division
- Multi-Family Division
- Mechanical Problem
- Electrical Problem
- Pre-Construction Problem

Each team is coached by local industry professionals and includes previous team members who provide new skill learning opportunities, team building, and leadership development.

The Sacramento State teams continued their legacy of success in February 2010 by setting a school record of 5 wins and the Heavy Civil Team winning "closest to the pin" for their excellent presentation:

ASC Competition

The Associated School of Construction (ASC) Student Competition held each year in February in Reno is one of the largest construction management and construction engineering events in the nation. Teams of students must create a proposal consisting of an estimate, a schedule, a logistics plan, and answers to a number of special problems. This competition tests students' ability to work as a team and affords students an opportunity to exercise the knowledge they have gained from the Construction Management Program at Sacramento State.

This competition brings together all the Construction Management schools on the west coast for intense competition that closely resembles what students will experience after graduation, on the job.

For the past six years, generous contributions made to the Sacramento Construction Management Education Foundation (SCMEF) have provided both financial resources and coaching support for Sacramento State teams to compete in the ASC Student Competition in Reno.
