YEAR IN REVIEW

The Annual Sporting Clay Shooting fundraiser, held in September 2019, was a huge success, grossing \$48,276. SCMEF's *Evening With Industry* event, which included 30 students, toured Teichert's aggregate crushing facility. A team of six undergraduate students brought home a first-place win from the ASC Concrete Solutions Competition in Chicago and three of our teams achieved third-place wins at Reno's ASC Competition in February. Covid-19 forced the University to go virtual in March, in turn, SCMEF and its supporting companies committed to making accommodations for summer interns. And, in May, the Scholarship Committee awarded \$7,500 to eight deserving students.

ASC STUDENT COMPETITIONS

The 33rd Annual **ASC Student Competition in Reno for Regions 6 & 7** yielded three 3rd-place wins for Sacramento State's Construction Management students. The Design Build team continued their dominate ways, reaching the podium for the 13th time, not far behind them, the Concrete Team reached it for the 12th time, and the Heavy Civil team reached it for the 7th. Award criteria included estimating, bidding, planning, scheduling, presentation skills, creativity, understanding of sound construction techniques, and thoughtful methodologies. SCMEF is proud to support the competitors, and would like to thank the coaches, corporate sponsors, and participating CSUS faculty for helping make this very important event so successful.

Sacramento State's Construction Management students achieved another historic win at the **ASC Region 3 Concrete Solutions Competition in Chicago**. This undergraduate team of six took 1st-place, making this a total of 12 national wins in the past seven years (nine 1st-place, one 2nd-place and two 3rd-place).
